








## Stephanie's Story: Joined a club I never wanted to be part of...


#### Biopsy

Port placed










- Full time employment (waitress)




## Diagnosis & Treatment

- Left MRM/ALND




## Diagnosis & Treatment



- Stage II IDC, mucinous. ER/PR (+) Her2 (-)
- No family hx of cancer at all
- Genetics: BRCA 1/ BRCA2 negative.

## Diagnosis & Treatment

- Chemotherapy
- Tamoxifen "hormone blocker"
- Reconstruction

## Unique Challenges/ Juggling Act
